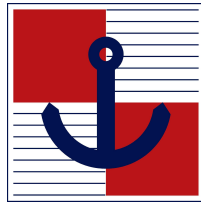

Paper should be written: in English, in Microsoft WORD, Times New Roman, 11 point small letters

TITLE OF PAPER (12 point capital letters, bold, centred)

Title of section (dressed to the left margin, 11 point small letters, bold)

Bibliography (dressed to the left margin, 11 point small letters, bold)

Text of bibliography (dressed to the left margin, 11 point small letters, number)

Abstract in English centred, 11 point small letters, bold, max 250 words

Abstract in author's native language, 11 point small letters, bold, max 250 words

Text of a paper with figures and tables should be not longer than 10 pages.

Poster guide

Poster should be printed in size A1 –portrait version- and posted in tube (roll).

Glossy is recommended.
